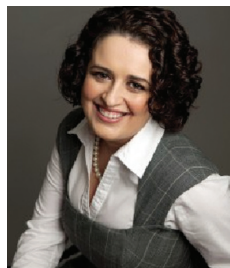


### **Jonathan Jones** – Eco Envolve *Creative Thinking & Resilience in Community Organisations*
