The Play bus Project is a rural response to a rural problem - that of tackling the fundamental isolation experienced by disadvantaged families. The aim of the project is to deliver play sessions for children who are socially disadvantaged with a specific focus on Travellers and New Communities. The Play Bus promotes and raises the awareness of various cultures and traditions within the Parent & Toddler, Holistic Play Sessions, Homework Support and Family Support services and in this way will contribute to creating a welcoming and positive atmosphere for all children accessing the Play Bus in County Roscommon. It will also provide a space for Adult Education programmes.

The Bus Drivers role includes:

- Safely driving the bus to designated venues throughout the County for activities.
- Ensure safe operating of the bus while driving and when stationary.
- Preform daily safety and maintenance checks.
- Provide support to activities on the bus including Adult and Children services
- Check the condition of a vehicle's tires, brakes, windshield wipers, lights, oil, fuel, water, and safety equipment to ensure that everything is in working order.
- Make minor repairs to vehicles.
- Other duties to support the service.

Applicants must hold a full clean D Licence and be eligible for Community Employment.

With Community Employment guidelines this role is for nineteen and a half hours per week
