Social Prescribing Coordinator

The Social Prescribing Coordinator will be responsible for establishing, developing and coordinating this new service in County Roscommon. The role involves assessing the needs of clients referred to the service and then linking the client with the activity, group or service in the community which best fits their needs. The SP Coordinator will know the key activities and supports available locally and will have established links with each activity being included in the Social Prescribing initiative.

The successful applicant will be required to have:

- 3rd level qualification in Community Development/ Social Science or a related field
- an in depth knowledge of local services Community/Voluntary/Statutory services and supports including a knowledge HSE services
- Ability to identify needs and arrange activities accordingly
- Experience of working one to one with clients
- Kindness/empathy and good listening skills
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent computer skills- Word, Excel and Email
- Access to own transport at all times during the working week

Conditions of Work:

- The position is part-time role starting with a 4-day week from April 2020 to June 2020 and with an expected 3-day week from July 2020 to June 2021 depending on funder approval.

- Salary is at the rate of €15.38 per hour. (€28,000 pro-rata.)
