1 x Dedicated Resettlement Support Worker

Objectives: The main objective of the role are to support refugees in the first weeks post arrival in the community. To develop and deliver programmes and activities to promote participation and inclusion in society and to develop mechanisms that promote self – sufficiency and independent living. To deliver the Refugee Resettlement programme of work outlined in the job description applicable to the role.

Location: This worker will operate from the Roscommon LEADER Partnership offices, Roscommon Town and on an outreach basis based on business need from any of the Roscommon LEADER Partnership extensive range of bases in Co. Roscommon.

Objectives: The main objective of the role is to provide Interpretation, translation and cross cultural support to recently arrived refugees who will be resettled in County Roscommon. It will involve assisting the Dedicated Resettlement Worker, volunteers and relevant services to interact effectively with the new arrivals via interpretation and translation of documents. To deliver the Refugee Resettlement programme of work outlined in the job description applicable to the role.

Location: This worker will operate from the Roscommon LEADER Partnership offices, Roscommon Town and on an outreach basis based on business need from any of the Roscommon LEADER Partnership extensive range of bases in Co. Roscommon.
